ACTION PLAN FOR 2022

1.0 Introduction

The Prestea Hun-Valley Municipal Assembly has initiated several Development Projects which are currently under various stages of completion. These projects are both funded from internal and external sources. The projects cover various aspects of the Municipal's Development and in accordance with development activities over which the Assembly has jurisdiction. These projects ranging from the construction of Health and Educational Infrastructure, Water and Sanitation, Roads Re-shaping, Youth Employment Programme, Capacity Building for both Staff and Assembly members among others. The MPCU has put together this annual action plan based on certain criteria.

The criteria used in the selection of projects and programmes for the annual plan includes the following;

- On-going projects
- Projects to create jobs
- Projects that are Gender Responsive
- Projects whose cost could be accommodated within the year's development budget
- Projects with the potential of alleviating poverty and in line with Municipal's priorities
- Projects which require immediate awareness creation through public education programmes.

The Action Plan specifies the title of the project and its location, their start and end dates as well as amounts involved. It spells out the sources of funds for the project, whether internal or external agents and who are the implementers. The details of the annual action plan are presented in the attached sheets. In all there are One Hundred and Seventy-Six (176) projects and programs. The projects are Forty-Two (46) representing 26.1 percent whereas the remaining Hundred and Thirty (130) are programs representing 73.9percent.

1.1 Budget

The Prestea Hun-Valley Municipal Assembly will need an amount of **Twenty-Six Million, Four Hundred and Ninety-Seven Thousand, Nine Hundred and Nineteen Ghana Cedis Eighty-Four Pesewas (GHC26,497,919.84)** to wholly implement the programmes, projects and activities spelt out in the 2022 Action Plan. The cost of implementing each Strategic Goal is presented as follows;
